Itinerary Changes

In the unlikely event of an itinerary change while sailing, we will communicate our new plan both through ship-wide (outside of cabin) announcements and through an updated *Daily Program*. Neither Atlantis nor Holland America shall be held liable for any damages resulting from any itinerary change according to your Passenger Ticket Contract.

Policy Notes

Please note that the Holland America Cruise Ticket contains references to both a cancellation charge and fuel surcharges that do not apply to this charter.

Documents & Registration

Register Online and Book Shore Excursions Now

All guests must register online. Please take a few minutes to register online for this cruise to obtain a full copy of your cruise documents from Holland America. Once registered, you should print the cruise ticket to allow you to check in quickly and board in just minutes. Please visit the following link by July 17 to register:

There is also a link on the atlantisevents.com website. You will need both your Holland America booking number and your passport number to register. Please note that this booking number is different from the Atlantis Confirmation Number. You should have received this by email from us if your reservation is complete and we received your signed confirmation form.

You may also book shore excursions and purchase onboard amenities from the same site.

Review Your Travel Documents

No paper documentation is required to board this cruise since all records are stored electronically. All you need is your passport and a valid credit card for incidentals. Luggage tags will be available at the pier.

Please be sure you are booked correctly for all elements of your vacation. Also note that your acceptance of both the Atlantis Confirmation Letter and the Holland America Passenger Cruise Contract constitutes acceptance of the conditions contained therein.

Passport Requirements

A valid passport is required for all guests. Visas are not required for citizens of the US and Canada. Visa requirements for all other nationalities vary and should be checked with the embassy or consulate of each country visited on this itinerary.

Please note that it is your responsibility to have the necessary documentation before boarding the ship. Failure to provide proper and valid documentation will result in denied boarding, and no refund will be provided.

Currency Advice

The entire ship operates on U.S. Dollars. The current rates of exchange for our ports (as of July 1) are:

Euro (EUR)	\$1 USD = EUR 0.73
Norwegian Kroner (NOK)	\$1 USD = NOK 6.17
Danish Kroner (DKK)	\$1 USD = DKK 5.46
Swedish Kroner (SEK)	\$1 USD = SEK 6.70

We highly recommend using your ATM card to get the best rate of exchange in cash, just be wary of bank fees. There are plenty of ATM machines throughout our ports. You'll get the best exchange by using a credit cards for large purchases.

Packing Advice

Indoor Clothing

Atlantis emphasizes a casual, comfortable atmosphere with no specified dress code. Sportswear and casual resort attire are appropriate at all times. There are no formal nights, and absolutely no need for a jacket and tie.

The only real rule is that no T-shirts, tank tops, or shorts are permitted in the Pinnacle Grill and Tamarind restaurants. These are premium experiences and we want to maintain a quality ambience for all our guests. Thank you for understanding and cooperation on this one.

Outdoor and On Shore Clothing

For daytime and outdoor wear, bring comfortable city touring clothing. Sportswear, lightweight outerwear, and comfortable loose clothing are very appropriate. You should also bring a lightweight jacket for port days and exploring. A hat can come in handy as well. Comfortable walking shoes are essential.

That said, we also recommend bringing a pair or two of shorts. It can actually be warm during some of this itinerary and we hope to host a few of our t-dances outdoors!

Party Themes

Atlantis theme parties might warrant something special, but these, of course, are always optional. You'll be comfortable with or without an outfit. Please note that all of the following evening parties are indoors. T-Dances will be held outdoors if weather permits.

- **Kit Kat Klub** - Decadence rules as we sail away from Berlin. Naughty or nice, crazy or conservative, fluffy or fetish. Welcome to our fantasy land where everything goes.
- **Conquest** - Vikings, cossacks, kings, & serfs. It's all happened here. Come as a conqueror, peasant, or just join the army of onlookers.
- **White Nights Party** - Light up the northern sky with an all-night party decked out in white.
- **Classic T-Dance** - The spirit of the 70s returns for 2 zany hours of retro fun when we all had too much real hair and a fascination with artificial fabrics.
- **Absolut T-Dance** - The land of Abba awaits on our last day and we'll celebrate superior Swedish style as we sail on.

Miscellaneous Packing Advice

If you are taking any medications, please make sure you bring them in your carry-on, in their original prescription containers, to avoid delays in customs.

Plan for uncertainty. Pack at least one change of clothes in your carry-on bags in case your bags are lost or mishandled en route. And please do not pack any valuables (cameras, jewelry, electronics, etc.) in your checked luggage.

Getting Ready

Weather Forecast

Mid summer weather in these ports is generally mild, but can be wet at times. You can expect daytime temperatures to be around 74°F / 22°C and lows around 55°F / 13°C. It may feel cooler onboard the ship due to wind. We have seen heat waves as well, with temperatures as high as 85°F / 26°C

Baggage Considerations

Check with your carrier for specific allowances. The standard international limit is 50 lbs. per piece. Excess or overweight bags may incur a substantial surcharge, so please plan accordingly.

Do not place any valuables, especially your passport, in checked luggage. If you do so, it is at your own risk. Always keep your hand luggage with you. And please be sure each piece of luggage has a luggage tag listing your name and complete address.

What if the Airlines Lose My Luggage?

If your luggage does not arrive in Copenhagen with you, please do all of the following:

1. Get a complete report from the airline, including a receipt and tracking number for your luggage. Make sure that you tell the airline that you are boarding the *Eurodam*, and tell them that the ship sails at 4:00 pm.
2. Upon arrival on the ship, go immediately to the Guest Relations Desk on Deck 1. The Guest Relations staff will attempt to track your luggage and follow up directly with the airlines.
3. Be patient. Depending on the airline it might arrive in Copenhagen. Our port agents, in concert with the ship, will attempt to deliver any lost luggage directly to your room. If your luggage does not arrive, we will keep you informed with the latest news from your airline.

Please realize that neither Holland America nor Atlantis has lost your luggage. We can only assist you in recovering your luggage from the airline and in communicating with them. Ultimately, the airline is responsible to you for any loss or inconvenience you encounter.

Getting There

Arrival to the Port in Copenhagen

The *Eurodam* will depart from Copenhagen's new OceanKaj Terminals. Please note that this port is new and is about 20 minutes from the center of the city. The address is:

100 Osterbro Pier No: 300-334 100, DK-2150 Nordavn

Taxis are readily available from the airport or city and take approximately 25 minutes from either. Cost is about US \$40-45. All taxis in Copenhagen accept credit cards for payments (with a service fee added).

Holland America is offering convenient transfers from the airport to the ship if you are flying in on July 20. You must pre-book these by calling 866-929-2332 no later than July 17. The cost is \$44 per person.

When Should I Check In?

Embarkation begins at Noon and you may arrive to the ship anytime until 3:00 pm. Guests occupying suites will have express lines for check-in. We highly recommend arriving after 1:30 pm to avoid the inevitable queues when we open the ship.

Eurodam sails at 4:00 pm sharp on July 20.

What do I Need to Check-In?

All you need to check in is your confirmation details (ideally printed out), your passport and a valid credit card for onboard charges, to check in for the cruise. You will then be issued a ship identification card, which will serve as your room key and identification card for boarding and re-boarding the ship.

Upon arrival to the port, you will check in, pass through security, and your luggage will be transferred by porters to your stateroom. Please carry any documents and valuables in your hand luggage.

Onboard Eurodam

Personal Funds & Shipboard Charges

The currency on board is U.S. dollars. Holland America ships operate on a cashless system. You can validate your Holland America charge card with your Visa, MasterCard, Novus, or American Express card, or sign for payment by cash or traveler's check. Guests can then sign all on-board services and purchases to their account. At the end of the cruise, you will receive a completely itemized statement.

For your convenience, the ship has an on-board ATM machine that dispenses U.S. currency. Bank debit cards on the PLUS and CIRRUS networks and the following credit cards: American Express, Discover/Novus, MasterCard and VISA are accepted. Fees will be charged per transaction.

Room Features

The rooms on the *Eurodam* are very comfortable, with all the modern amenities you'd expect on a premium cruise ship. The ship has both 110 (US standard) and 220 (European) voltage power outlets in the rooms. All the water onboard is filtered and potable.

Each stateroom is equipped with a hair dryer.

Customs & Immigration at Sea

At each port of call, customs and immigration officials may board the ship and clear it before we are allowed to go ashore. Normally, this occurs without your knowledge or participation. Occasionally, passengers are called for inspection. In these cases, please follow the instructions provided to assure that we are able to disembark in a timely manner in each port.

Shore Excursions

You can pre-book shore excursions in advance on the Holland America web site (HollandAmerica.com) until July 17th. Upon arrival to the ship, you will receive tickets for your pre-booked excursions in your stateroom. You may purchase additional shore excursions onboard, subject to availability, at the Shore Excursions Desk or through your TV set using the system in your room.

Atlantis has worked closely with Holland America to enhance and develop excursions that will be fun and exciting for our group. Most of the excursions are "exclusive" to Atlantis guests. If you are in doubt, please inquire with shore excursions before booking.

Finally, we strongly recommend the Holland America shore excursions on this sailing over the "third party" tours that you might find online. Our experience in the Baltic has been that guests on tours through other operators have had many problems, and offer no protection in case of an itinerary change or delay.

Laundry & Dry Cleaning Services

Laundry, dry cleaning, spot removal, and pressing services are available for a reasonable fee. Laundry bags and service request forms are in your room. Ask your cabin steward for details. There are also no self-service laundry facilities onboard.

There are no irons in staterooms as they constitute a fire hazard. Please note that portable irons are not permitted for the same reasons.

Gratuities and Tipping

All standard gratuities have been prepaid for this week, so there is no tipping required or expected at any time. All cabin stewards, waiters, and other personnel have been compensated at levels that are customary for a charter of this size. No additional tipping is needed but may be extended at your discretion if the service is exceptional.

A 15% gratuity is automatically added to all bar purchases and spa service charges.

Smoking Policy

For the comfort of all of our guests, designated smoking and non-smoking areas are available throughout the vessel. All staterooms, stateroom balconies, dining areas, and showrooms are non-smoking. Smoking is permitted only in specific areas of the ship, which will be detailed in the program onboard. As a courtesy to our guests, ship personnel will thoroughly enforce the smoking policy.

If You Have a Problem or Question

Both the Guest Relations Desk and the Atlantis Desk can handle most any difficulty you may encounter. Generally, issues relating to your stateroom, the ship, schedules, or billing should be directed to the Guest Relations Desk. Questions regarding entertainment, service, special requests, or anything else should be directed to the Atlantis Desk. Questions about excursions should go directly to the Shore Excursions Desk.

If the Atlantis Desk is unattended, please feel free to ask any Team Atlantis member and they will assist you.

Important Guest Notice

Please remember that all our guests are bound by Holland America's Passenger Ticket Contract. The policy is intended to help ensure that all guests are able to participate in a safe and enjoyable cruise experience and sets forth standards of conduct for guests to follow throughout their vacation. Please take a minute to read the contract on their website:

Although we shouldn't have to say this, please remember that both Holland America and Atlantis have a zero-tolerance policy towards all illegal substances and behavior that violates the above policy. Any violation could result in your vacation being terminated early, or worse.

If a guest is found in possession of an illegal substance, appropriate action will be taken, which may include removal from the ship and involvement of appropriate authorities, which may result in prosecution. Guests removed from the ship pursuant to this policy are responsible for their own accommodations and transportation home, at their expense and no refund will be offered for the unused portion of your cruise.

Spa Services

The *Eurodam* features an exceptional full-service spa, offering a wide range of services, including massage, facial, aromatherapy, hairstyling, and much more. Appointments for these services should be made early in your cruise, as many of the services book up early. All spa services are an additional charge which can be signed to your stateroom.

Spa appointments will open on embarkation day, immediately following the boat drill, in order to be fair to all our guests. Guests in Suites may reserve Spa appointments beginning at 3:00 pm in the Neptune Lounge.

Alcoholic Beverage Restrictions

Holland America does not allow alcoholic beverages to be brought aboard the ship for consumption during your cruise vacation. Any alcohol brought onboard or purchased onboard will be held in secure storage and delivered to your stateroom on the last night of the cruise.

You may bring wine or champagne to be consumed in the restaurants with an \$18 corkage fee applied for each (750ml) bottle. See the Holland America policy for more complete details.

Medical Services

Should you require medical attention while on board, an infirmary staff is available to assist you 24 hours a day. A doctor is available to render services at a customary charge. The infirmary is capable of providing treatment for minor matters which may arise during your cruise and are capable of assessing and stabilizing most medical emergencies. Should you require treatment for a serious condition which requires hospitalization, then arrangements may be made to transfer you to a medical facility ashore. While at sea, the ability to transfer you to a shore side facility may be limited or delayed by weather or logistical considerations. If you are currently suffering from a serious medical condition, please consult with your personal physician prior to sailing. The onboard doctors are independent contractors..

Important Health Notice – Please Read!

If you should come down with a contagious disease, or even suspect a contagious disease, it's compulsory that you report it to the ship's infirmary for the safety of everyone on board. Should you be on any medication, or want the medical staff to be aware of any special needs, please contact the infirmary. This will ensure that they will be prepared should you need assistance.

In rare instances, the ship's medical staff may determine that your medical condition will require you to be quarantined in your stateroom to protect the health of our other guests. While both Holland America and Atlantis will make every effort to make you comfortable in such a situation, we are unable to compensate lost vacation time due to quarantine.

Please note that the ship follows CDC guidelines on all quarantine issues, and there is little flexibility in applying the rules, particularly where gastrointestinal symptoms are present.

As always, we highly recommend travel insurance to assist with unforeseen costs and reimbursement for missed vacation time due to illness of any type. If you do not have travel insurance, it can be purchased virtually right up to departure time.

Atlantis Cruise Essentials

Team Atlantis & Information Desk

Our Team Atlantis is on hand throughout the ship to host and assist with every aspect of your vacation. Please don't hesitate to ask any of us if you have a question or require assistance. We are available 24 hours a day, and are always wearing Atlantis name badges.

We also offer a general information desk located adjacent to the Guest Relations Desk on Deck 1. Hours for this desk vary by port and are posted in the *Daily Program*. Atlantis management can be reached through Guest Relations at any time.

Holland America Daily Program

The Atlantis version of *Holland America Daily Program* will be delivered to your stateroom each night with a complete schedule for the following day. All activities, shows, and function times are described in this newsletter and handy pocket card. Please remember that this is our primary method of communicating with you, so read it daily. Changes and/or updates from our original schedule are common during a cruise, particularly in case of inclement weather.

Atlantis Roommate Share Program

If you are participating in our roommate share program, you have been assigned a roommate based on smoking preferences. Your roommate's name may appear on your confirmation, but is subject to change. This program is offered as a convenience and service for our single travelers, and as such no roommate changes are permitted for any reason whatsoever.

Upon arrival, you will find a detailed letter in your stateroom with advice on how best to enjoy your cruise together.

Special Events for Singles

We host several special events throughout the week for our single guests, ranging from cocktail parties to special dinners. Please see the *Daily Program* for information on specific events.

All of these dining times are approximate, and will change slightly according to our port times and onboard events. Additional dining options are listed in the *Daily Program*.

Team Atlantis will be on hand at the restaurant to seat you, answer questions, and host tables. We always encourage you to join tables for meals. It's the best way to meet our other guests!

Please be patient during peak hours as there may be a slight wait in the Main Restaurant. We recommend dining before 7:30 pm or after 8:30 pm to avoid waiting in line. We have scheduled the dining times to allow you to enjoy a show either before or after a meal.

Room service is available 24 hours a day at no additional charge. See the menu in your stateroom for a complete selection. Please recognize that the staff handling room service has limited capabilities. If you're looking for a quick snack, we highly recommend the Lido Cafe, which is open almost 24 hours a day.

Pinnacle Grill and Tamarind Restaurants

For the ultimate special occasion, discover the Pinnacle Grill, with an extraordinary menu featuring a selection of outstanding classic and modern creations. Or visit Tamarind, our Asian speciality restaurant with delights from around the continent.

Reservations are essential, and may only be made for same day dining. In fairness to all our guests, reservations must be made in person, and only one reservation per stateroom will be accepted daily. Each restaurant is equipped to handle parties no larger than eight (and only a few tables are this size), and larger groups will not be accepted. Please respect these policies so that the maximum number of our guests may enjoy these unique dining experiences. See the Daily Program for reservation times.

Suite guests may reserve a total of two advance bookings for the cruise through the Neptune Lounge Concierge.

Shorts, T-shirts, and tank tops are not permitted in these premium restaurants.

An extra charge for dining applies.

Singles Dining

Traveling solo doesn't mean you have to eat alone. Whenever you enter our restaurants, our Team Atlantis will graciously seat you with our other guests. Also, we're creating two special singles dinners, along with a designated meeting place for single guests to gather for drinks before dinner. Special Diets

We ask that you submit any special dietary requests in writing directly to Holland America at least one week prior to sailing. Once onboard, please speak with the Maitre D' of the restaurant regarding any special requests.

Please note that since this cruise is "open seating," it is your responsibility to notify the server and/or Maitre D' of any special requests you have made every time you dine.

Here are a few tips on our destinations that might be helpful in planning.

Oslo

It's our first visit to the capital city of Norway, and there's a lot to see and do in one of the most gay-friendly cities on the planet. With our long stay, we recommend taking one of the city tours in the morning and spending the afternoon and early evening enjoying one of the city cafes or shops. We should docked right in the heart of the city (subject to change of course), so you'll find it easy to get around.

City highlights include the Sculpture Park, Opera House, Royal Palace and the many Edward Munch paintings at the National Gallery. We recommend downloading the free VisitOSLO app before leaving the USA so you have a guide in your pocket!

Gothenburg

We're docked just across from the center of Sweden's second largest city. It's an easy 20-minute walk, or short train ride into the city. Highlights there include a fantastic art museum, a beautiful waterfront, and some of the best food in Europe.

Berlin/Warnermunde

This one is easy. If you haven't been to Berlin -- go. The train ride is fun, private and shorter thanks to faster trains. Take advantage of our late stay there to explore the city's incredible cultural attractions and vibrant street life. We've customized all the tours to give you a full day with plenty of time to explore on your own.

If you decide to stay in Warnermunde, you'll find a charming German beach community with typical shops and restaurants. We love it, but it's not Berlin!

Tallinn

If you're not taking part in one of Holland America's many great excursions here, you can easily walk from the ship to the heart of the Old Town, where you'll find Toompea Castle, an exquisite Russian Orthodox Cathedral and a maze of medieval cobblestone alleyways.

City Information

Telephone Access Onboard

Direct ship-to-shore telephones are provided in each guest stateroom. You may easily place a call to friends, relatives or business associates during your cruise, reception permitting.

All phone calls, whether inbound or outbound, are charged a satellite tariff. Outbound calling rates are posted near your cabin telephone and will be billed to your on-board account. These charges are applied to ALL calls including calls to 800, 877 and 888 numbers. Please do not use a credit card or phone card; your on-board account will be billed in addition to the cost of the phone card or charges to your credit card. Collect calls are not possible from the ship. Connecting to a Holland America Line vessel at sea is simple by using DialAShip.com. A credit card is required for all inbound phone calls to a ship. The rate is \$USD16.00 per minute and billing begins at the time specified. Please have the ship's name, your party's name and stateroom number.

Instructions:

Dial 1-866-HAL-SHIP (1-866-425-7447). From outside the U.S. access 1-732-335-3278.

Listen to the announcement.

Listen to the menu and select the number that corresponds to the ship you are calling.

If you receive a busy signal or message, please hang up quickly and try your call again.

Internet Access Onboard

The *Eurodam* has an Internet Cafe open 24 hours a day for an additional per-minute charge. Please note that the public computers do not have file sending or receiving capabilities.

There is wireless access available in most areas of the ship, for a fee. Remember that internet access at sea is much slower than broadband access. After all, you do have to go through a satellite link!

Finally, we recommend turning all mobile broadband devices to "Airplane Mode" while onboard. They tend to hold onto an IP address that another user could be utilizing.
