Cabo San Lucas Update

As most of you know, Cabo San Lucas sustained significant damage during hurricane Odile in September. However, most of the hotels and tourist attractions are scheduled to be operational by October 1. At this time we are still planning our port call there, and truly believe that while some services may not be fully functional they need our support and business. The only way this tourism-dependent region can recover is by getting back to normal and hosting guests as quickly as possible. Please show your support to this region during our visit as best you can. We will offer ways to support the area directly with details to follow onboard.

Should anything change and we are not able to call on Cabo San Lucas, we will notify you in advance by email with an updated itinerary. Thank you for understanding.

Itinerary Notes

Please note that all arrival and departure times are approximate and may change without notice.

Atlantis and Princess Cruise Lines have carefully planned this itinerary for maximum enjoyment of all our ports and the ship. Although we do our best to adhere to published ports and times, unforeseen weather and/or sea conditions may force us to alter the itinerary during your cruise.

In the unlikely event of an itinerary change while sailing, we will communicate our new plan both through ship wide (outside of cabin) announcements and through an updated Princess *Patters*. Neither Atlantis nor Princess Cruise Lines shall be held liable for any damages resulting from any itinerary change according to your Passenger Ticket Contract.

Get Organized

Register Online With Princess Cruises

Atlantis will send you your Princess booking number by email. You may then register online for this cruise with Princess Cruises in order to check in quickly and get onboard quickly. Please visit the following link to access the Princess Cruises Cruise Personalizer.

Review Your Travel Documents

No paper documentation is required to board this cruise since all records are stored electronically. All you need is your passport and a valid credit card for incidentals. A copy of your cruise ticket may be downloaded from the Princess website (Princess.com) once you have registered for your cruise. Luggage tags may be printed as well or may be picked up at the pier upon arrival.

Place one of the preprinted luggage tags on each of your checked bags prior to arrival at the pier. Additional luggage tags will be available at the pier.

Documentation Requirements

A valid passport is preferred, and required for all guests from outside the U.S.A. Proof of citizenship in the form of an original birth certificate and a government issued photo ID is acceptable for U.S. citizens only. Visas are not required for citizens of the US and Canada. Visa requirements for all other nationalities vary and should be checked with the embassy or consulate of each country visited on your itinerary.

Please note that it is your responsibility to have the necessary documentation before boarding the ship. Failure to provide proper and valid documentation will result in denied boarding, and no refund will be provided.

Currency Advice

The entire ship operates on U.S. Dollars. The current rates of exchange for Mexico (as of September 24) is:

Mexican Peso (MXN) \$1 USD = \$N 13.24

We highly recommend using your ATM card to get the best rate of exchange in cash, just be wary of bank fees. There are plenty of ATM machines throughout our ports. You'll get the best exchange by using credit cards for large purchases.

Packing Advice

On Board Clothing

Atlantis emphasizes a casual, comfortable atmosphere with no specified dress code. Sportswear and casual resort attire are appropriate at all times. There are no formal nights, and absolutely no need for a jacket and tie.

Our only real rule is that no tank tops or shorts are permitted in any of the specialty restaurants at dinner. Please respect this rule for our premium dining experiences for all guests. The staff at these restaurants will ask you to change.

On Shore Clothing

Plan for warm, even hot weather with slightly cooler breezes at night. We recommend loose, comfortable cottons and other lightweight clothing. Don't forget a hat!

Except for the above notes, our ports are very relaxed with few dress codes. We suggest casual resort wear and some really comfortable shoes. Some tours involve long bus rides and/or considerable walking so comfort is essential.

Our Party Themes

Our theme parties might warrant something special, but these, of course, are always optional. You'll be comfortable with or without an outfit. All events take place in either the Calypso Pool or Terrace Pool, depending on weather.

- **Dog Tag T-Dance** - Join forces with our forces for a military-themed kick-off party. We'll ID you all with Atlantis dog tags – which for many is the only outfit you need.
- **Under the Sea** - Get down in a whole new way at our underwater fantasy world! Mermaids, mermen, sailors, lost swimmers, lifeguards, mythic heroes, and all other sea creatures welcome. Or don some goggles and enjoy the show.
- **Revival – Classic Disco T-Dance** - Flash back to the days when music had lyrics, everyone had too much hair, and unnatural fabrics reigned. We'll take you to the halcyon days of disco for two glorious hours in the afternoon.
- **Treasure Island** - Our floating tropical island of wonder comes to life with a treasure trove of characters ranging from prancing pirates to sparkling natives to dazzling creatures of the deep. You'll even see the occasional stranded (Carnival) cruise ship guest. Get lost with us for a night and who knows what you might find.
- **The White Party** - One simple color. Endless possibilities. Dress pure white – something everyone certainly can find. Any way you want.
- **Soaked T-Dance** - It'll be hot, hot, hot in Mexico, so we'll cool things off by getting you wet, wet, wet. Our soaker of a t-dance is guaranteed to drench one and all. Swimsuits and water-friendly gear essential for our silliest party yet. Cameras and phones a very bad idea. You will get WET!

Miscellaneous Packing Advice

Bring plenty of sunblock, as the sun can be deceptively intense. Also, bring your own basic toiletries as the onboard stores are not open when in port.

Plan for uncertainty. Pack at least one change of clothes in your carry-on bags in case your bags are lost or mishandled en route.

Don't put your passport in your checked luggage!

Prohibited Items

Please do not bring any of the following onboard, and do not place these items in your checked luggage: Irons (including travel irons), alcoholic beverages, knives, firearms, or any other potentially dangerous item.

If your luggage contains any of the above items, your bag will be held at security and will not be delivered to your stateroom. Full details on prohibited items can be found on the Princess Cruises website.

Getting Ready

Weather Forecast

Early fall weather in these ports is generally pleasant and warm. You can expect high temperatures around or above 86°F / 30°C and lows around 73°F / 23°C. Rain is rare at this time of the year, but not impossible. It will feel cooler onboard the ship due to wind.

Baggage Essentials

Most airlines limit checked bags and carry-on luggage. Check with your carrier for specific allowances. The standard limit is 50 pounds (23 kilos) per piece. Excess or overweight bags may incur a substantial surcharge, so please plan accordingly.

Do not place any valuables, especially your passport, in checked luggage. If you are taking any medications, please make sure you bring them in your carry-on, in their original prescription containers, to avoid delays in customs. Always keep hand luggage with you.

Please be sure each piece of luggage has a luggage tag listing your name, and complete address. Affix the preprinted cruise luggage tags only before heading to the pier.

What if the Airlines Lose My Luggage?

If your luggage does not arrive with you, please do all of the following:

1. Get a complete report from the airline, including a receipt and tracking number for your luggage. Make sure that you tell the airline that you are boarding *Golden Princess*, and tell them that the ship sails at 4:00 pm.
2. Upon arrival on the ship, go immediately to the main reception where they will make a copy of your lost baggage report. The ship will attempt to track your luggage and follow up directly with the airlines.
3. Be patient. Depending on the airline it might arrive prior to sailing. Our port agents, in concert with the ship, will attempt to deliver any lost luggage directly to your room. If your luggage does not arrive, they will keep you informed with the latest news from your airline.

Please understand that neither Princess nor Atlantis has lost your luggage. We can only assist you in recovering your luggage from the airline and in communicating with them. Ultimately, the airline is responsible to you for any loss or inconvenience you encounter.

Check-In and Embarkation

Getting to the Port of Los Angeles

We will depart from the Port of Los Angeles as follows:

Golden Princess will dock at berth B93.

Driving Directions

Take the 110 Freeway South towards San Pedro.

Exit at Harbor Boulevard (same exit as the Vincent Thomas Bridge).

Stay to the right - Harbor Boulevard (Do not go over the bridge.)

At the light, cross over the main road, turning right into the "World Cruise Center"

Follow the directions to parking and passenger drop-off.

Parking is available across the street from the cruise terminal. The cost is \$12 per day and is payable in cash or credit card.

A taxi from LAX will cost around \$75.

When Should I Check In?

We begin check-in around 12:30 pm, with embarkation around 1:00 pm. All guests must be onboard by 3:30 pm. Please note that due to another charter the week before us, we will NOT begin check-in until 12:30 pm and you will not be allowed in the terminal building until around noon. Please do not arrive any earlier than noon, or you will spend the morning standing outside in the sun!

Our best advice is to arrive after 1:30 pm. We'll get you onboard quickly with a minimum of waiting in line.

Golden Princess sails at 4:00 pm sharp on October 5.

What Do I Need to Check In?

Since your reservation is completely electronic, all you need is your proof of citizenship and a valid credit card to check in for this cruise. You will then be issued your stateroom key, which will serve as your room key, charge card, and identification card for boarding and re-boarding the ship.

Upon arrival to the port, you will check in, pass through security and porters will transfer your luggage to your stateroom. Please carry any documents and valuables in your hand luggage.

If you have created a Boarding Pass on the Princess website, check-in will be considerably expedited.

Onboard Golden Princess

Personal Funds & Shipboard Charges

The currency onboard is U.S. Dollars. Princess ships operate on a cashless system. You can validate your Princess Charge Card with your Visa, MasterCard, Discover, American Express card, or sign for payment by cash or traveller's check. Guests can then sign all onboard services and purchases to their account. At the end of the cruise, you will receive a completely itemized statement.

For your convenience, the ship has an onboard ATM machine that dispenses U.S. currency. Fees will be charged per transaction.

Room Features

The rooms on the *Golden Princess* are very comfortable, with all the modern amenities you'd expect on a premium cruise ship. The ship has both 110 (US standard) and 220 (European) voltage power outlets in the rooms. All the water onboard is filtered and potable.

Each stateroom is equipped with a hair dryer.

Customs & Immigration at Sea

At each port of call, customs and immigration officials will board the ship and must clear it before we are allowed to go ashore. Normally, this occurs without your knowledge or participation. Occasionally, passengers are called for inspection for a variety of reasons. In these cases, please follow the instructions provided to assure that we are able to disembark in a timely manner in each port.

Although we shouldn't have to say this, you may not bring any type of illegal or controlled substance onboard. Anyone found to be in possession of an illegal substance will be disembarked and reported to the local authorities.

Shore Excursions

You can pre-book shore excursions in advance on the Princess website (Princess.com) until October 2nd. Upon arrival to the ship, you will receive tickets for your pre-booked excursions in your stateroom.

You may purchase additional shore excursions onboard, subject to availability, at the Shore Excursions Desk.

Atlantis has worked closely with Princess to enhance and develop excursions that will be fun and exciting for our group. Many of the excursions are "exclusive" to Atlantis guests, although in some cases the tours may be mixed with guests from other cruise ships. If you are in doubt, please inquire with Shore Excursions before booking.

Gratuities and Tipping

All standard gratuities have been prepaid for this week, so there is no tipping required or expected at any time. All cabin stewards, waiters, and other personnel have been compensated at levels that are customary for a charter of this size. No additional tipping is needed but may be extended at your discretion if the service is exceptional.

Laundry & Dry Cleaning Services

Laundry, dry cleaning, spot removal and pressing services are available for a reasonable fee. Laundry bags and service request forms are in your room. Ask your cabin steward for details.

There are no irons allowed in staterooms as they constitute a fire hazard.

Smoking Policy

For the comfort of all of our guests, designated smoking and non-smoking areas are available throughout the vessel. All dining areas are non-smoking. All showrooms are non-smoking. Smoking is permitted only in the casino and on certain open decks. As a courtesy to our guests, ship personnel will thoroughly enforce the smoking policy.

Smoking is not permitted at any time in any stateroom or on the balconies onboard. Violators may be fined for cleaning costs.

Please note that Atlantis and/or Princess reserves the right to change the smoking policy at any time depending on guest requirements.

Alcoholic Beverage Restrictions

PLEASE READ THIS POLICY REGARDING BRINGING ALCOHOL ONBOARD

Princess Cruises reserves the right to limit or refuse alcoholic beverages to be brought aboard the ship for consumption during your cruise vacation. Any alcohol brought onboard or purchased onboard will be held in secure storage and delivered to your stateroom on the last night of the cruise.

As provided in the Passage Contract, passengers agree not to bring alcoholic beverages of any kind onboard for consumption, except one bottle of wine or champagne per adult of drinking age (no larger than 750 ml) per voyage, which will not be subject to a corkage fee if consumed in your stateroom. Additional wine or champagne bottles are welcome, but will incur a \$15 corkage fee each, irrespective of where they are intended to be consumed. Liquor, spirits or beers are not permitted. Please remember that luggage will be scanned and alcohol outside of our policy will be removed and discarded.* Alcoholic beverages that are purchased duty free from the ship's gift shop, or at ports of call, will be collected for safekeeping and delivered to the passenger's stateroom on the last day of the cruise. A member of the ship's staff will be at the gangway to assist passengers with the storage of their shore-side alcoholic purchases while our Boutiques staff will assist passengers with shipboard alcoholic purchases. Cases of water may not be brought onboard.

Spa Services

The *Golden Princess* features an exceptional full-service spa, offering a wide range of services including massage, facial, aromatherapy, hairstyling, and much more. Appointments for these services should be made early in your cruise, as many of the services book up early. All spa services are an additional charge, which can be signed to your stateroom.

Spa appointments will open on Sunday afternoon, immediately following the boat drill, in order to be fair to all our guests. The spa will be open earlier that day for tours and same-day appointments.

Medical Services

Should you require medical attention while on board, an infirmary staff is available to assist you 24 hours a day. A doctor is available to render services at a customary charge. The infirmary is capable of providing treatment for minor matters which may arise during your cruise and are capable of assessing and stabilizing most medical emergencies. Should you require treatment for a serious condition which requires hospitalization, then arrangements may be made to transfer you to a medical facility ashore. While at sea, the ability to transfer you to a shore side facility may be limited or delayed by weather or logistical considerations. If you are currently suffering from a serious medical condition, please consult with your personal physician prior to sailing. Princess's doctors are independent contractors.

Important Health Notice – Please Read!

If you should come down with a contagious disease, or even suspect a contagious disease, it's compulsory that you report it to the ship's infirmary for the safety of everyone on board. Should you be on any medication, or want the medical staff to be aware of any special needs, please contact the infirmary. This will ensure that they will be prepared should you need assistance.

In rare instances, the ship's medical staff may determine that your medical condition will require you to be quarantined in your stateroom to protect the health of our other guests. While both Princess and Atlantis will make every effort to make you comfortable in such a situation, we are unable to compensate lost vacation time due to quarantine.

Please note that the ship follows C.D.C. guidelines on all quarantine issues, and there is little flexibility in applying the rules, particularly where gastrointestinal symptoms are present.

As always, we highly recommend travel insurance to assist with unforeseen costs and reimbursement for missed vacation time due to illness of any type. If you do not have travel insurance, it can be purchased virtually right up to departure time.

Dining Notes

All of these dining times are approximate, and may change slightly according to our port times and onboard events. Additional dining options are listed in *Princess Patters*.

Team Atlantis will be on hand at the main restaurant to seat you, answer questions, and host tables. We always encourage you to join other guests for meals. It's the best way to meet people! Both Atlantis and Princess will do our best to honor special seating requests.

Please note that we will stagger the opening and closing times of the three main restaurants, and will publish approximate times in *Princess Patters*.

Please be patient during peak hours as there may be a slight wait in the main restaurant. We recommend dining before 8 or after 9 pm to avoid any waiting in line. We have scheduled the dining times to allow you to enjoy our shows either before or after dinner.

Crown Grill, Sabatinis, & Crab Shack Speciality Restaurants

Golden Princess features three outstanding specialty restaurants, perfect for a night out with friends or a romantic evening. Crown Grill steak house offers luscious grilled steaks and fish in a warm, clubby setting. For an authentic Italian experience, head to Sabatinis where old world charm meets a modern market-fresh menu. And the Crab Shack recreates an East-coast seafood house with casual fun and a fantastic fresh seafood.

Reservations are essential, and may only be made for same day dining. In fairness to all our guests, reservations must be made in person, and only one reservation per stateroom will be accepted daily. Each restaurant is equipped to handle parties no larger than eight (and only a few tables are this size), and larger groups will not be accepted. Please respect these policies so that the maximum number of our guests may enjoy these unique dining experiences.

Suite guests may reserve two advance visits. See *Princess Patters* for details and booking times.

Shorts and tank tops are not permitted in Crown Grill or Sabatinis. There is no dress code for Crab Shack.

An extra charge applies for all specialty restaurants.

Room Service

Room service is available 24 hours a day at no additional charge. See the menu in your stateroom for a complete selection and ordering instructions. Please recognize that the staff handling room service has limited capabilities. If you're looking for a quick snack, we highly recommend the Horizon Court, which is open almost 24 hours a day.

Singles Dining

Traveling solo doesn't mean you have to eat alone. Whenever you enter our restaurants, Team Atlantis will graciously seat you with our other guests. Also, we're creating several special singles dinners, along with a designated meeting place for single guests to gather for drinks before dinner every night. See *Princess Patters* for specific times and locations.

Special Diets

We ask that you submit any special dietary requests in writing directly to Princess at least one week prior to sailing. Once onboard, please speak with the Maitre D' of the restaurant regarding any special requests.

Please note that since this cruise is "open seating", it is your responsibility to notify the server and/or Maitre D' of any special requests you have made every time you dine.

Vegetarian and low fat options are available at each meal.

Atlantis Cruise Essentials

Atlantis Roommate Share Program

If you are participating in our roommate share program, you have been assigned a roommate based on smoking preferences. Your roommate's name may appear on your confirmation, but is subject to change. This program is offered only as a convenience for our single travelers, and as such no roommate changes are permitted for any reason.

Upon arrival, you will find a detailed letter in your stateroom with advice on how to best enjoy your cruise together.

Should you desire to move to a single room, BOTH parties will have to pay the full fare upgrade fee onboard. There are no exceptions to this rule.

Finally, any roommate share guest who does not adhere to our code of conduct may be asked to leave the ship in the next port. In such cases no refund nor travel assistance will be provided.

Special Events for Singles

We host several special events throughout the week for our single guests, ranging from cocktail parties to special singles-only dinners. Please see *Princess Patters* for information on specific events. There's a singles event essentially every day.

Daily Schedule

The Atlantis version of *Princess Patters* will be delivered to your stateroom each night with a complete schedule for the following day. All activities, shows, and event times are described in this newsletter and handy pocket card. Please remember that this is our primary method of communicating with you, so read it daily. Changes and/or updates from our original schedule are common during a cruise, particularly in case of inclement weather.

You can also find an interactive version of the daily program on your television. Our cruise directors also host a daily update show that's both informative and entertaining.

Team Atlantis & Information Desk

Team Atlantis is on hand throughout the ship to host and assist with every aspect of your vacation. Please don't hesitate to ask any of us if you have a question or require assistance. We are available 24 hours a day, and are always wearing Atlantis name badges.

We also offer a general information desk located on Deck 3 adjacent to the Guest Relations Desk. The desk is open daily and is your central resource for Atlantis-related information. Hours vary and are posted in *Princess Patters*.

Atlantis management and office staff can also be reached through Guest Relations at any time.
